CAE introduces simulation-based intelligent deployment solution for first responders

- CAE Deploy will provide decision support for emergency management personnel

Orlando, Fla., November 26, 2007 – (NYSE: CGT; TSX: CAE) – CAE today announced at the Interservice/Industry Training, Simulation, and Education Conference (I/ITSEC) the launch of a simulation-based decision support solution for intelligent deployment of first responders called CAE Deploy.

The Ottawa Paramedic Service communications centre will use CAE Deploy beginning in February 2008.
